

WILMINGTON PLAN AMENDMENT STEERING COMMITTEE (WPASC)
Code of Conduct

1. All members of the Steering Committee, staff, and the community are expected to act in an orderly manner and to refrain from personal attacks, the use of invective or profanity, or any language exhibiting bias on account of race, religion, ethnicity, sexual preference, sex, profession or occupation.
2. Persons present at a Steering Committee meeting are expected to conduct themselves in an orderly manner and to refrain from disrupting the meeting, interfering with other persons' right to address the Steering Committee and interfering with the conduct of business by the Steering Committee.
3. In the event that any speaker or audience member does not comply with the foregoing requirements, or if a speaker does not address the specific item being discussed by the Steering Committee, he/she will be ruled out of order, his/her speaking time forfeited, and the facilitator will call upon the next speaker.
4. Any speaker determined to be out of order shall forfeit his or her remaining speaking time. If the disruption continues, the facilitator may ask that the speaker be removed from the meeting.
